



Fear Not!

Dear Partner,

After meditating on February's Partner Letter, I pray you have gained a greater desire to win and influence the lost! We (the children of God) have an awesome responsibility in these last days, to influence people for Jesus like never before. Keep your eyes and heart open so you can seize the opportunities that come your way!

I am convinced that as Christians we have missed out on a lot that God has for us because of fear. **Hosea 4:6** says **My people are destroyed (cut off) for lack of knowledge:** We cut ourselves off from God's best by walking in fear. When we fear, we are not walking in the knowledge of the Truth of God's Word.

In order for us to be free from fear, one thing we must realize---"We have the power!" **Luke 10:19** says **Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.** As you can see, we have the power over **ALL** the power of the enemy! It didn't say over "some" or "most" of the power of the enemy; but it says we have power over and above **ALL** the power of the enemy. What is the enemy's power? Fear! **He only has the power that we give him, through fear.** There are so many areas that the body of Christ has been walking in fear in. Fear of death, fear of failure, fear of accidents, fear of destruction, fear of lack, fear of what people will think, fear, fear, fear. Do you know when you worry, you are in fear? Do you know when you are frustrated, you are in fear? You are fearing that your efforts are fruitless? When you dread doing something you are in fear. The reason the devil brings fear is to try to have you believe in something that opposes the Word of God. All fear is contrary to the Word of God. Also, all fear is opposes of one of God's promises. **There is a promise in God's Word that can annihilate every fear that you may have!**

II Timothy 1:7 say **For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.** So since God isn't the one that is giving it, we don't need to accept it! More than 60 times in the Bible is says "Fear not...". God would not tell us to do something without giving us the ability and authority to do it. So the fact that the Word tells us to **fear not** should give us faith to know that we not only have the authority to **fear**

not, but the ability to conquer it too! There is SO much that I can say about this subject, but I am going to summarize it. We must stop putting all of the blame on God and /or the devil for everything that either *is not* happening in your life or *for everything that is happening that *is not good*.* **Satan cannot do anything TO us apart from fear and God cannot do anything FOR us apart from faith.** We are the ones who determine who is working for us. If we are in fear, Satan is working for us; if we are in faith, God is working for us.

5 Steps to Annihilate Fear In Your Life, Forever

1. *Recognize* that fear is there.
2. *Find a verse* (or verses) in the Bible that cover your situation.
3. *Speak the verse(s)* of promise over your life.
4. *Take action* against the fear.
5. *Keep speaking and acting* to keep that Word in you.

I will list some verses that will help you to get started with step #2.

The Fear

1. Accidents/Destruction/Terror
2. People harming you or coming against you
3. Failure
4. What people think of you
5. Lack/Not having enough
6. God won't answer your prayer
7. You will never have the things you want in life
8. Death
9. Worry
10. Not being healed
