“POSSESSING THE DOUBLE”

Dear Partner,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I pray that you are walking in God's goodness.

According to **Isaiah 61:7**, the Bible says *For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.* It is time for the Body of Christ to begin to possess all that God has promised us. The word **possess** means **to occupy by driving out previous tenants and possessing in their place; to seize, to inherit; to expel, cast out, consume without fail, take possession and seize upon.** So many people are sitting around hoping for a blessing to fall out of the sky when God is telling us to possess the double. According to this scripture, we have to put action to our faith. After all, faith **is** an action word. The Bible says in **James 2:17** *Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.* The Bible also says in **James 1:22** *But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.*

We Christians must fight the good fight of faith to obtain what is rightfully ours. And one of the greatest ways to possess our inheritance is through prayer. **Luke 16:16** says, *The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.* So in order to seize our inheritance we must press in by praying and getting the Word on a constant basis! It also says in **verse 17** *And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail.* **God cannot fail!** All He knows is victory. We only fail when we stop following God and start doing things our way.

Psalms 23:1 says *The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.* The key to this scripture is allowing God to be our Shepherd. The Shepherd protects the sheep and provides for them when they are following him. When the sheep decide to leave the covering of protection, they put themselves in the danger zone. So many people have gone astray and become their own shepherd. As a result, they have left what God has for them. The good news is--it is not too late to come back and began to possess what our Father has already prepared for His children. **I Corinthians 2:9** says *But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.*

Many people have been tempted to give up but know this--- **God has not given up on you!** He says in **Galatians 6:7-9** ⁷ *Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.* ⁸ *For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that*

soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.⁹ And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. I like what Jacob told the angel in **Genesis 32:26** "...And he said, I will not let thee go, except thou bless me. This needs to be our testimony. I realize some people have been through a lot, but remember what David said in **Psalm 66:12** *Thou hast caused men to ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water: but thou broughtest us out into a wealthy place.* (Notice, they went through it...they did not stay in the rough times.) Saints, it is time to possess the double!

Steps to Possessing the Double

- 1.** Believe the Word and Confess the Word daily. **Hebrews 10:23** says, *Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)*. God is faithful to His Word, so let's keep His Word on our lips at all times.
- 2.** Press in through your prayer and your determination. When you pray, don't pray the need, find where your need is met in the Word and pray the Word.
- 3.** Don't stop until you see manifestation. In **Exodus 22:7**, it says *...if the thief be found, let him pay double.*
- 4.** Remember **II Chronicles 20:17** *...set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.*
